

"Expert teacher in Europe - improving professional competences" is a project aimed at the teachers of Zespół Szkół Ogólnokształcących nr 6 in Bydgoszcz. Its main objective is to improve the professional competences of all the teachers involved through participation in methodology and language courses. Our goals are improved quality of teaching, better quality of work and activities in favour of pupils, enhanced employability and improved career prospects as well as increased motivation and satisfaction in everyday work.

There will be twenty-four teachers participating in the mobility activities. Maths/Informatics, Physics, Business Studies, Music and PE teachers as well as our school librarian (a Polish teacher in charge of the student government) will attend methodology courses in the United Kingdom. They will gain inspiration and teaching ideas for their classes and have an opportunity to exchange ideas and good practices with teachers from other European



countries. Our foreign language teachers will attend methodology courses in France, Germany, Ireland and the United Kingdom. The remaining twelve project members will participate in language improvement courses. Physics, Maths, German, French, History and Social Studies and PE teachers as well as a school librarian will focus on improving their English while a PE teacher will improve her German.

The envisaged results and impact:

- improved quality of education,
- improved methodological and linguistic competences,
- integration of good practices and new methods (including ICT) into daily activities,
- improved curriculum,
- Erasmus+ KA2 and eTwinning projects carried out at school.

The potential longer term benefits:

- increased quality of the school's educational offer,
- reinforced cooperation with partners from abroad,
- increased capacity to work at EU level,
- enhanced intercultural awareness.
